Positive Behavior Rewards

This year our school will be using an electronic behavior management system called PBIS Rewards to help us recognize students for their positive behavior. Although we are not a PBIS school, this program is a technology based positive behavior management system that is perfect for helping us track and reward students for doing the right thing! You can learn all about the PBIS Rewards platform at their website (www.pbisrewards.com).

Our behavior expectations are outlined using the acronym **SOAR**. When students meet these expectations throughout the day, they are rewarded with electronic points they can redeem for privileges, tangible items, access to events, and other cool things. Our expectation is that we will see overall behavior improve throughout the school and that the number of administrative referrals will decrease. Parents will receive more information via CTLS Parent, but in the meantime, ask your child to log in via Clever to show you the points they have earned already!
